Community Lawyering is a process through which lawyers contribute their legal knowledge and skills to support community identified initiatives that return power to the community and that support lasting changes that bring about social justice. The Community Lawyering approach stresses the importance of thinking beyond litigation (while retaining litigation as a vital tool) in addressing the kinds of structural problems low-income communities face. In this course, you'll learn how to garner and activate issues identified by the community, lead a successful advocacy and media campaign, and facilitate leadership. We'll share real-life examples from groups across the country.
